By airplane

Amsterdam Schiphol Airport

The entrance of the train station is located in the main entrance of Schiphol airport; take the intercity to The Hague and transfer to the commuter train to Rotterdam. (see: *By public transport*).

Rotterdam The Hague Airport

Arriving at Rotterdam The Hague Airport the train station of Rotterdam centre can easily be reached with the airport shuttle bus (line 50) or RET bus line 33.

Arriving at airports in **Brussels or Paris**; the Thalys or TGV trains are good connections to reach Rotterdam Central Station. From there transfer to the commuter train to The Hague. (see: *By public transport*).

By public transport

To use public transport in the Netherlands, you will need the 'OV-Chipkaart' (public transport chip card), check the information desk at the airport.

Traveling with the **intercity trains from Schiphol Airport/Leiden/The Hague**, change at The Hague HS and take a commuter train (Sprinter) to Rotterdam CS (approx. 4 times per hour). Get off at Delft Zuid station.

Travelling with the **intercity trains from Utrecht or Antwerp/Breda/Dordrecht**, change at Rotterdam CS and take a commuter train (Sprinter) to The Hague CS or Leiden (approx. 4 times per hour). Get off at Delft Zuid station.

From Delft Zuid station you can walk in approx. 5 minutes to our office at Vlinderweg 6 (see map for the right direction). Coming from the direction Rotterdam, you first have to cross the rail track by the stairs. Turn left when you leave the train station and cross the road at the traffic lights. Walk further through a small green lane towards the office buildings in front of you. NEN is situated in the second building. If you arrive at Delft Central Station take bus 60 or 80 (direction "Tanhof") and get off at bus stop "Kalfjeslaan". Walk a few meters back to the Kalfjeslaan and turn right there. You can then see our office building at some 300m distance. Travelling time is approx. 10 minutes.
